As per report received, notice issued to respondent has been received back with the report '*not residing at given address as informed by his father*'. Considering the fact that petitioner has given the same address in his divorce petition and his father has been duly informed. He deemed to be duly served. He has not come present today. Hence, proceeded against ex-parte.

Heard.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition titled as '**Vineet Sharma versus Sonia**', filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that three cases are already pending between the parties before the Courts at Panchkula.

Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.

Considering the distance between Karnal and Panchkula and the fact that three other cases are already pending before the Courts at Panchkula, the petition titled as 'Vineet Sharma versus Sonia', filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, (Family Court) Karnal is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Panchkula who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
