Respondent has not come present despite service.

Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record as well.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for transfer of petition bearing No. DMC/742/2017 filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (Annexure P-1), titled as **'Vipin versus Preeti'** pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Rohtak to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two cases filed by the petitioner, one under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and another under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure are pending in Kurukshetra Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and in order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, the petition bearing No. DMC/742/2017 filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (Annexure P-1), titled as '**Vipin versus Preeti**' pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Rohtak is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Kurukshetra who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.

Since, the main petition has been allowed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, also stands disposed of.
