Prayer is for transfer of petition, i.e. HMA/522/2017, titled as *Hem Raj Singh Versus Neeta*, filed under Section 12(1)(C) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in Court of learned Additional District Judge, Mohali, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

It comes out that respondent is settled in United States of America.

The learned counsel for respondent has stated that petitioner is a practising lawyer at Jalandhar Courts. Therefore, he has objection, if case is transferred from Mohali Courts to Jalandhar Courts. However, he agrees if the case is transferred from Mohali Courts to SBS Nagar Courts (Nawanshahr Courts), to which learned senior counsel for petitioner also has no objection.
