Reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13(1) (ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Fatehabad.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that three other cases are already pending between the parties at Fatehabad Courts. There is distance of about 250 Kms. between Fatehabad and Gurugram. Therefore, it is difficult for the petitioner to pursue her case at Gurugram Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, the petition filed under Section 13(1) (ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955,

pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Fatehabad.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
