1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

Petitioner seeks transfer of a civil suit titled as “*Amarjit Kaur etc. vs Punjab State etc.*”, filed by respondent Nos.1 to 6, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurdaspur, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a widow lady of 52 years old. It is difficult for her to go to Gurdaspur Courts for hearing. Respondent Nos.2 and 5 are police officials and threatening her.

I am of the view that a civil suit is to be tried by the Court, which has ordinary jurisdiction. Just for convenience of the petitioner, the case cannot be transferred to District Courts, Ludhiana.

If some threats are being given by respondent Nos.2 and 5, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the police and make an appropriate compliant.

There is no ground to transfer the aforesaid case. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
