Counsel for the appellants would contend that the present appeal directs challenge against the judgment and decree dated 04.09.2017 passed by the Additional District Judge, Rewari whereby the judgment and decree dated 11.03.2014 passed by the trial Court in favour of the appellants by dismissing the suit of the respondent/plaintiff came to be reversed. Counsel would further submit that in the suit respondent No.3- Smt. Lado was ex parte and Hari Ram – respondent No.4 filed the written statement admitting claim of plaintiff/respondent No.1. It is further submitted that dispute between the appellants, respondent No.1/plaintiff, respondent No.2 and 5 has been settled by way of compromise dated

08.02.2018 and appeal may be disposed of in terms of the compromise. It

is further submitted that this compromise does not adversely affect the rights of respondents No.3 and 4 nor of a third party.

Counsel representing respondents No.1, 2 and 5 have conceded to the factum of compromise, contentions/submissions made by counsel for the appellants and would state that appeal may be disposed of in terms of the compromise.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of in terms of the compromise effected between the appellants, respondents No.1, 2 and 5.
