Heard.

Report received that mediation has failed.

Petitioner seeks transfer of four cases from Jhajjar Courts to Rewari Courts. Three cases are as under :-

(i) HMA Case No. 333 of 2016, titled as *Ravinder Singh alias Situ Versus Jyoti Singh*

(ii) case pertaining to FIR No. 128, dated 22.12.2016, registered under Sections 354 (A)(1) and 509 IPC at Women Police Station, Jhajjar,

(iii) case pertaining to FIR No. 68, dated 12.7.2016, registered under Sections 498-A, 506 IPC at Women Police Station, Jhajjar, and

(iv) case under the Domestic Violence Act, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jhajjar.

The only ground mentioned is that whenever she goes to attend

the Court, she is threatened. No specific instance has been mentioned in the petition. It also comes out that three other criminal cases are lodged against respondent by petitioner at Jhajjar Courts in the year 2016 and divorce case is also filed by respondent at Jhajjar Courts. The imaginary threat cannot be made the ground to transfer four cases to Rewari Courts where petitioner has shifted after filing of those cases.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that life and liberty of petitioner may be protected.

I am of the view that if there is specific instance of any threat or offence being committed against petitioner, she can always approach the police or the Court with appropriate complaint as she has already done the same thrice earlier by lodging the FIRs.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
