Petitioner seeks transfer of petition titled as *Jasbir Kumar Versus Sunita Rani*, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, from the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

It comes out that respondent is living abroad. The learned counsel for respondent states that petitioner has got 17 years old daughter and cannot pursue her case at Hoshiarpur Courts.

Considering the facts and circumstances, petition titled as *Jasbir Kumar Versus Sunita Rani*, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur, is withdrawn from the said Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, who may retain the case with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, petition is allowed.
