Petitioner seeks transfer of civil suit for declaration to the effect that plaintiff/respondent No. 1 is full owner of suit land and consequential relief for permanent injunction, titled as *Raj Kumar Versus Ravinder Kaur and others*, from the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gurdaspur, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that one suit is already pending at Amritsar Courts. The plea is same as in suit at Amritsar Courts and also regarding bank account.

I am of the view that if petitioner/respondent No. 1 feels that suit has been filed at wrong Court, she can always take objection in this regard in written statement and same will be decided by the trial Court. There is no ground to transfer the case from Gurdaspur Courts to Amritsar Courts. Therefore, instant petition is dismissed.
