The learned counsel for respondent has placed on file the copy of the order dated 12.5.2017, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Guruharsahai, vide which present petitioner has been proceeded against ex parte.

Heard.

Petition filed by respondent-husband under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Amandeep Singh Versus Neha*, was stated to be pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur. It is informed by learned counsel for respondent that now said petition has been transferred to Ferozepur Courts. The petitioner seeks transfer of said petition to Jalandhar Courts on the ground that one case under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is already pending at Jalandhar Courts and that it is difficult for petitioner who is only 20 years old to go to Ferozepur Courts on every date of hearing.

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Considering the difficulty expressed by petitioner, petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for restitution of conjugal rights, titled as *Amandeep Singh Versus Neha*, now stated to be pending before the Ferozepur Courts is withdrawn from the said Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar, who may retain the case with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, instant petition is allowed.
