Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, in terms of order dated 19.03.2018, has not been issued as the appellant failed to comply with order dated 19.03.2018 with regard to deposit of Rs.25,000/- in the Registry towards litigation expenses to be paid to the respondents who were called upon to appear in the Court to the limited extent of exploring possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties.

A relevant extract from order dated 09.05.2018, reads as follows:-

“Counsel for the appellant prays for time to comply with order dated 19.03.2018.

Last opportunity is provided for necessary compliance within a period of three weeks, failing which the appeal shall be deemed to be dismissed.

On necessary compliance notice in terms of order dated 19.03.2018 be issued for 19.09.2018.”

The appellant has not only failed to comply with order dated 19.03.2018 but there is no representation on his behalf to say

something in the matter. In the given scenario, the appeal is bound to fail for want of necessary compliance of order dated 19.03.2018.
