Heard.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code for transfer of the petition titled as '*Sarabjit Singh vs. Harmeet Kaur*' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Taluka Court Patti, District Taran Taran to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Baba Bakala, District Amritsar.

It is stated that the petitioner has got two minor children aged 6 years and 3 years, respectively, who are living with her and it is very difficult for her to attend the Court at Patti, District Taran Taran. Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, the petition titled as '*Sarabjit Singh vs. Harmeet Kaur*' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Taluka Court Patti, District Taran Taran is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division, Baba Bakala, District Amritsar.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
