CM-5150-C-2018 is for placing on record additional affidavit in support of condonation of delay. Perused. Sufficient cause has not been shown to condone the delay of 252 days in presenting the appeal. The reasons assigned are that initially competent authority has taken a decision to not to prefer appeal. Later on such decision was reversed at the behest of some other officer and proceeded to present the appeal. The reasons are not

sufficient to condone the delay of 252 days. The appellant being a State they were aware of the limitation and so also department should have taken a decision whether to file appeal or not within the stipulated period and top priority should have been given in respect of Court matter. In view of these facts and circumstances, appellants have not made out a case so as to condone the delay of 252 days.

Accordingly, CM-5150-C-2018 as well as RSA-999-2018 stand dismissed.
