Petitioner seeks transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955 bearing registration No.HMA /32/2017 titled as *Navneet Sharma vs. Nisha Sharma* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Hoshiarpur to family Court at Pathankot.

Heard.

It comes out that one case filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is already pending in the Family Court at Pathankot. Petitioner is stated to be in government job at Nakodar. Her son is living at Pathankot with her parents. Respondent is stated to be working in Merchant Navy and stationed at Kolkata.

In these circumstances, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955 bearing registration No.HMA /32/2017 titled as *Navneet Sharma vs. Nisha Sharma* is withdrawn from the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Hoshiarpur and is transferred to the Court of

District Judge Family Court at Pathankot. It is further directed that the Family Court at Pathankot shall first make endeavour for compromise between the parties.

The present petition stands allowed accordingly.
