Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

It comes out that the respondent has refused to put in appearance.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.DMC/36/2015 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Pardeep Kumar vs. Pooja* pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rajpura to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar.

It is contended that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are already pending at Jalandhar Courts. Petitioner is unable to come from Jalandhar to Rajpura to pursue her case.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition bearing no.DMC/36/2015 filed under Section 24 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Pardeep Kumar vs. Pooja* pending before

the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rajpura is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.

Since the main case has been allowed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
