Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Hunny Barri vs. Sonia* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Ambala to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as well as complaint under Section 498-A IPC are already pending at Chandigarh Courts. It is stated that Ambala is at a distance of approx. 50 kms. from Chandigarh and she is unable to pursue her case at Ambala.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent has opposed the prayer. Copy of the statement made, wherein petitioner has given her

Ambala address.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is now living with her parents, who are residents of Chandigarh.

Considering that two cases between the parties are already pending at Chandigarh Courts and the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Hunny Barri vs. Sonia* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Ambala is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Chandigarh, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.

Since the main case has been allowed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
