Heard.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gurwinder Singh vs. Saloni* pending before the Court of learned District Judge, Gurdaspur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is residing at village Gehri Jandiala RS, District Amritsar. Therefore, it is difficult for her to attend the proceedings at Gurdaspur. It is further stated that one case under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and another under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 were filed at Amritsar Courts, which have been dismissed in default and petitioner is going to file application for restoration of the same.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and the fact that two cases are likely to be completed at Amritsar, the petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Gurwinder Singh vs. Saloni* pending before the Court of learned District Judge, Gurdaspur is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Amritsar, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.

Since the main case has been allowed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
