Reply again not filed. Further adjournment for filing of reply is declined. Since, the petitioner is not present, case of the petitioner has been considered. Present petition has been filed for transfer of petition bearing no.HMA 358 of 2016 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Harbhajan Singh vs. Rakesh Kumari* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge (Family Court), Gurdaspur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Hoshiarpur.

It comes out that the petitioner belongs to village Tooran, Tehsil Mukerian, Distt. Hoshiarpur. It is stated in the petition that a petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. was allowed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mukerian. Petitioner is unable to travel alone all the way to Gurdaspur to pursue the case. It comes out that Mukerian falls between Gurdaspur and Hoshiarpur. Distance between Mukerian and

Hoshiarpur is 62 kms which is much more than the distance between Mukerian and Gurdaspur i.e. 24 kms. There is a direct road from Mukerian to Gurdaspur.

Keeping in view the matter, there is no ground to transfer the petition.

Resultantly, the present transfer petition stands dismissed.
