KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks transfer of a Civil Case No.6 of 25.01.2017 titled as “*Dinesh vs Seema*” pending in the Court of Shri Pardeep Choudhary, learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar to a court of competent jurisdiction at District Courts, Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two cases between the parties are already pending at District Courts, Sirsa. It is further contended that the respondent forcibly married the petitioner and even once threatened her to commit suicide in front of her house. Petitioner has apprehension that if she goes to Bahadurgarh, her life will be at risk.

Respondent has not appeared despite service.

Consequently, Civil Case No.6 of 25.01.2017 titled as “*Dinesh vs Seema*” pending in the Court of Shri Pardeep Choudhary, learned Addl.

Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar is withdrawn from his court and transferred to the court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Sirsa.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
