Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was transferred from Ferozepur to Faridkot by this Court, vide order dated 15.02.2016 passed in TA No.814 of 2015. Now the respondent has filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which is pending in the court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ferozepur, just to harass the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner seeks transfer of the said petition to a court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

In view of the matter, the petition titled as “*Manish Kumar vs Sonia*”, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending in the court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ferozepur, is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Faridkot, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
