Petitioner, who is working as a teacher in Government Middle School, Paljeta, seeks transfer of petition titled as '*Baljinder Singh vs. Gurjot Kaur*' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Rupnagar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

It is stated that one FIR case is already pending between the parties at Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for respondent in his reply dated 7.2.2018 filed in Court today, has opposed the prayer. In the reply, it has been alleged that petitioner had earlier assaulted the respondent at her residence at Rupnagar.

It is further stated that brother of the petitioner is working as an Advocate in Ludhiana Courts and, therefore, respondent has his own apprehension. However, respondent has no objection if the case is transferred to Samrala, District Ludhiana which is convenient to both the parties.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition titled as '*Baljinder Singh vs. Gurjot Kaur*' filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is withdrawn from the Court of learned District Judge, Rupnagar and transferred to the Court of Additional Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Samrala, District Ludhiana.
