Reply on behalf of respondent filed in Court is taken on record.

Arguments heard.

It comes out that one litigation between husband and wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is already pending at Amritsar Court. Now, the respondent has filed the divorce petition bearing No.80/2017 titled as *Manpreet Singh vs. Karuna Kiran* in the Court of learned District Judge, Tarn Taran. The wife prays for transfer of the said petition to Amritsar.

Keeping in view the fact that one litigation is already pending at Amritsar, the divorce petition bearing No.80/2017 titled as *Manpreet Singh vs. Karuna Kiran* is withdrawn from the Court of learned District Judge, Tarn Taran and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Amritsar, who may retain the file himself or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. However, it is directed that the Court concerned

shall first make efforts for reconciliation between the parties and if necessary by sending the case to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Amritsar.

The present petition stands allowed accordingly.
