Reply on behalf of the respondent filed in Court is taken on record.

Heard.

It comes out that four cases between the parties i.e. one under Section 125 Cr.P.C., one under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, one under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and one FIR case are pending at Yamuna Nagar Courts at Jagadhari. Therefore, it is proper that the petition bearing no.GW/23/2017 (Annexure P5) filed under Sections 10 & 25 of The Guardians & Wards Act, 1890 by the respondent titled as *Puneet Malik vs. Anika Malik* should be transferred from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Karnal to the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

As such, petition bearing no.GW/23/2017 (Annexure P5) filed under Sections 10 & 25 of The Guardians & Wards Act, 1890 by the respondent titled as *Puneet Malik vs. Anika Malik* is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Karnal and is transferred to the Court

of learned District Judge, Family Court, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
