Petitioner seeks transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Amandeep Chopra Versus Priya*, from the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patti, District Tarn Taran to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that three other cases between the parties are already pending at Faridkot Courts. It is difficult for petitioner to go from Faridkot to Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Considering the difficulty expressed by petitioner, the petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Amandeep Chopra Versus Priya*, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patti, District Tarn Taran, is withdrawn from said Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridkot, who may retain the case

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with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, petition is allowed. The Court at Faridkot is also directed to refer the matter to Mediation and Conciliation Centre, so that an attempt can be made to resolve the matrimonial dispute amicably.
