Main Case

Heard.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed by the husband-respondent under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Amandeep Puri vs Smt. Meenakshi @ Meenu”***, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, to a court of competent jurisdiction at Hissar.

It is stated that the petitioner-wife is having four years old child. The distance between Hissar and Jalandhar is approximately 300 Kms. and the petitioner-wife is unable to pursue her case at Jalandhar Courts.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent has raised objection for transferring the said petition on the ground that the respondent-husband has already lodged an FIR against the petitioner-wife at Jalandhar, which is to be tried at Jalandhar Courts.

This Court does not deem it proper to comment upon the merits of the divorce petition or the FIR. However, keeping in view the difficulty of the petitioner-wife that she has got four years old child and unable to pursue her case at Jalandhar Courts, the petition filed by the husband-respondent under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Amandeep Puri vs Smt. Meenakshi @ Meenu”***, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Hissar, who may try the case himself or entrust the same to a court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, present petition is allowed.
