This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition titled as '*Sanjeev Kumar vs. Pooja*' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court) SBS Nagar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

Heard, learned counsel for the parties.

It is stated that two other cases filed by the present petitioner are pending in the Ludhiana Courts i.e. one under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and another under Section 125 Cr. P.C. Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition titled as '*Sanjeev Kumar vs. Pooja*' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court) SBS Nagar is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Ludhiana who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
