KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **'Major Randhir Singh Suri verus Mrs. Gursimran Suri'** pending in the Court of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, SAS, Nagar Mohali and another petition filed under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 titled as **'Major Randhir Singh Suri verus Mrs. Gursimran Suri'** pending in the court of learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Chandigarh to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Heard.

I am of the view that Chandigarh, Panchkula and Mohali forms the tri-city and these are interconnected and traveling from one place to another is just like local traveling. Therefore, it cannot be said that there

is difficulty to any of the parties either at Chandigarh Courts or at Mohali Courts.

Therefore, no ground to transfer the case is made out and the same is dismissed accordingly.

Since, the main petition has been dismissed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, also stands disposed of.
