Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Respondent is reported to be not residing at the given address. Earlier, his counsel had refused the service, stating that he is not in touch with his client. In the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, the respondent has given his address as House No.3337/1, Sector 40-D, Chandigarh as rented accommodation. Since, no address is available, nor counsel is accepting the service, therefore, service of the respondent is dispensed with.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing HMA/77-2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Kamaljit Singh vs. Deep Mala* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Ferozepur.

Respondent has filed petition under Section 9 of Hindu

Marriage Act, 1955 at Chandigarh Courts. Petitioner claims that she is residing in Ferozepur City. She has also got a minor daughter, who is studying at Ferozepur and proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are also pending at Ferozepur Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner, petition bearing HMA/77-2017 filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Kamaljit Singh vs. Deep Mala* pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ferozepur who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
