Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Amrish Kumar @ Munish Kumar vs Ritu Rani*”, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

Reply to the petition has not been filed.

Heard.

It comes out that the respondent had earlier filed a divorce petition at District Courts, Fatehgarh Sahib. Vide order dated 18.02.2015 passed in TA No.133 of 2015, the said petition was transferred to District Courts, Patiala. Respondent withdrew the said petition from Patiala Courts and file the fresh petition at District Courts, Fatehgarh Sahib. One case under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is already pending at Patiala Courts.

Consequently, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Amrish Kumar @ Munish Kumar vs Ritu*”

Rani”, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Patiala, who may retain the case himself or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
