This is an application for transferring a divorce petition which the applicant filed at Kapurthala District to Jalandhar District.

The ground taken is that respondent No.1 is a judicial employee in Kapurthala District Court and therefore, no Advocate is willing to appear on behalf of the applicant.

Counsel for the respondent states that respondent No.1 is an employee of the Judicial Courts at Phagwara and the allegation that no Advocate at Kapurthala is willing to appear for the applicant is ex-facie baseless.

I find merit in the argument of learned counsel for the respondents.

Application stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
