Heard.

Respondent has filed report of Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat village Ramgarh Sardara, which shows that the petitioner is living for the last one year at village Ramgarh Sardara. Now, for the last six months, she is living in the house of Sikander Singh son of Malkit Singh, Lamberdar resident of village Ramgarh Sardara.

Learned counsel for respondent has placed on file map showing that distance between Ramgarh Sadara and Sangrur and Ramgarh Sardara to Ludhiana is almost same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no direct bus service from Ramgarh Sardara to Sangrur. Since, Ramgarh Sardara is not on the main road, therefore, connecting bus service is not available.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner got a

minor child maintaining at Ludhiana.

Since, distance between two places is same, therefore, there is no ground to transfer the petition.

Dismissed.

Since, respondent is stated to be in Army, therefore, the trial Court is directed to expedite the disposal of the case.

Since the main case has been dismissed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
