Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition No.HMA/435/2017, titled as “*Kamaljit Saini vs Sharndeeep Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Hoshiarpur, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Nawanshahar.

Heard.

It is stated that the petitioner has got one minor child. One case under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and another under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, between the parties are pending at S.B.S. Nagar, Nawanshahar Courts.

It comes out that there is a distance of about 61 Kms. between the two places. The respondent has further informed this Court that earlier a divorce petition by way of mutual consent was filed, which was withdrawn after first motion. Therefore, there is no ground to transfer the aforesaid petition from Hoshiarpur Courts to S.B.S. Nagar, Nawanshahar Courts.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.
