Heard. Petitioner seeks transfer of petition i.e. HMA No. 157 of 2017, titled as *Surender Singh Versus Anju*, filed under Section 13 (1) (i) (ia) (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Narnaul, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Bhiwani.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petition under 125 Cr.P.C. between the parties is pending at Bhiwani Courts. The petitioner has got a minor son. The petitioner is living in a village and has to change buses to reach Narnaul.

Considering the difficulty expressed by petitioner, petition i.e. HMA No. 157 of 2017, titled as *Surender Singh Versus Anju*, filed under Section 13 (1) (i) (ia) (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Narnaul, is withdrawn from said Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Bhiwani, who

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may retain the case with him or entrust the same to a Court of competent jurisdiction. Consequently, petition is allowed. Since main petition has been allowed, therefore, pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
