Petitioner seeks transfer of petition titled as *Deepak Versus Smt. Jasvir Kaur*, filed by respondent under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Karnal, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga, where the mother of petitioner is residing.
