Petitioner seeks transfer of petition bearing no.HMA/588/2016 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Keshiha Sharma vs. Pooja Sharma* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District Panipat.

It is stated that three other cases between the parties are already pending i.e. Under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 at Panipat Courts.

As such, to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, petition bearing no.HMA/588/2016 filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Keshiha Sharma vs. Pooja Sharma* pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari is withdrawn from the said

Court and is transferred to learned District Judge, Panipat, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction. He shall also ensure that all the cases triable by the Court of learned Additional District Judge are tried by one Court.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
