The petitioner is the wife and the respondent her husband. This petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transferring of the case under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Rakesh Kumar Vs. Rajbala' filed by the respondent, which is pending in the Court of District Judge, Jhajjar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

It is stated that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent on 09.05.1995. Two children namely Neeraj aged about 22 years and Paramvir aged about 19 years were born from this marriage. It is stated that the petitioner is presently working as BAMS Doctor and posted at Village Bhagana, Tehsil and District Hisar. It is very difficult for the petitioner to travel to Jhajjar to attend the Court there as the distance between Jhajjar and Hisar is more than 150 Kms.

Learned counsel for the respondent does not seriously object to the transfer petition. He, however, prays that trial of the case be directed to be expedited so that the affairs of the parties may be settled.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed. The case filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “Rakesh Kumar Vs. Rajbala’ pending in the Court of District Judge, Jhajjar is withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to Family Court at Hisar.

The parties may appear before the Family Court, Hisar on 31.08.2018.

The learned Family Court is requested to endeavour to decide the case expeditiously.
