Reply on behalf of the respondent has not been filed.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Harvir Singh vs Sharanpreet Kaur”***, pending in the Court of learned Addl. District Judge, Patiala, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Heard.

It is stated that the petitioner has got a minor male child, who is 70% mentally retarded. Therefore, it is difficult for her to go from Jalandhar to Patiala to pursue her case.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and the fact that today none has come present to oppose the petition, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Harvir Singh vs Sharanpreet Kaur”***, pending in the Court of learned Addl. District

Judge, Patiala, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Jalandhar, who may try the case himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
