Application supported by affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioner along with the summons is taken on record. It shows that the case is pending before Ms. Prabjot Kaur, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

In this case, respondent was duly served for the last date of hearing but he has not turned up to oppose the present petition.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Manjit Singh vs. Charanjit Kaur* pending in the Court of Ms. Prabjot Kaur, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at District SBS Nagar, Nawanshahr.

It is stated that mental condition of father of the petitioner is

not good. Therefore, she is unable to travel to Hoshiarpur.

Considering the said fact and the fact that the respondent has not come forward to oppose the present transfer petition, petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent titled as *Manjit Singh vs. Charanjit Kaur* pending in the Court of Ms.Prabjot Kaur, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), SBS Nagar, Nawanshahr, who may retain the same himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
