Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Karnal and thereafter, the respondent filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Fatehgarh Sahib. Prayer is for transferring the said petition from Fatehgarh Sahib Courts of Karnal Courts.

In order to ensure that both the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place and keeping in view the fact that none has come present to oppose the petition, the case No.HMA/57/2017, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “***Gurbhej Singh vs Gurinderjeet Kaur alias Gurwinderjeet Kaur***’, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)-I, Fatehgarh Sahib, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Karnal.
