Petitioner seeks transfer of petition No.HMA No.338/2016, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as “*Satvir Singh vs Puneet Nagra*” pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, and petition No.GA 192/16, filed under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, titled as “*Satvir Singh vs Puneet Nagra*” pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ludhiana, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Reply filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

Heard.

In the reply, the respondent has referred to some orders passed by the trial Courts, where the cases are pending, which are not relevant to decide the present controversy.

It is stated that the minor child, namely, Jai Aditya Singh is living with his mother at Panchkula. Therefore, in such case, only

Panchkula Court has the jurisdiction to try the case pending under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.

Regarding the other petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties should be tried and decided at one place, the petition No.HMA No.338/2016, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as ***“Satvir Singh vs Puneet Nagra”*** pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, and petition No.GA 192/16, filed under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, titled as ***“Satvir Singh vs Puneet Nagra”*** pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ludhiana, are withdrawn from the aforesaid Courts and transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Panchkula, who will try the cases himself. The transferee Court is also directed to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, so as to make efforts to amicable settlement between the parties.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
