This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the divorce petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. DMC No. 1558/2017 titled as **“Shri Varun Arora versus Smt. Heena”** pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Jalandhar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The respondent has furnished a copy of the order dated 1.8.2017 passed by this Court in **TA No. 530 of 2017** titled as **Honey versus Varun Arora**, filed by the petitioner vide which transfer of the earlier divorce petition on the same ground from Jalandhar Courts to Ludhiana Courts was declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the said divorce petition has been withdrawn by the petitioner and now fresh petition has been filed.

It being so, the provisions given by this Court for declining the transfer petition will hold the trial. Therefore, there is no ground to transfer the petition from Jalandhar to Ludhiana.
