Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 13(i-a) (i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Inderjeet Singh vs Jaskirandeep Kaur”***, pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court at Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari to a court of competent jurisdiction at S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that father of the petitioner is suffering from brain hemorrhage and she has a minor child aged about five years to bring up. Therefore, she could not attend the Court at Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.

Keeping in view the difficulty expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed under Section 13(i-a) (i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Inderjeet Singh vs Jaskirandeep Kaur”***, pending in the Court of District Judge, Family Court at Yamuna Nagar at

Jagadhari, is withdrawn from the said court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, who may retain the case himself/herself or entrust it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, present revision petition is allowed.
