This petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure praying for transfer of the case under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the respondent (husband of the petitioner) pending in the Court of Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent on 12.04.2007. From this wedlock, two daughters namely Maninder Kaur and Sukhwinder Kaur were born. The petitioner has been living at her parental house since 16.11.2010. She gave birth to another child on 20.02.2011 at her parental home. She states that the respondent did not even visit her to see new born child. She states that it is difficult for her to attend the courts proceedings at Ludhiana, which is at the distance of 80 Kms. from district Barnala.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed. The case filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act titled

as titled as 'Harjant Singh Vs. Beant Kaur' pending in the Court of Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court, at Barnala.
