KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition No.HMA/314/2017, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Ajay Kumar vs Pragya alias Hema*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Amritsar to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ambala.

Respondent has not turned up, despite service to oppose the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that three other cases between the parties are already pending at Ambala Courts.

Considering the distance between Amritsar and Ambala and to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, the petition No.HMA/314/2017, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Ajay Kumar vs Pragya alias Hema*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Amritsar, is

withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ambala, who may try the case himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
