Reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record.

The present transfer application has been filed for transfer of the divorce petition filed by the husband at Amritsar on the premise that already proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C and petition under Section 12 of the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 are pending adjudication at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the wife was allegedly thrown out of the house on 29.12.2017 and the divorce petition, *ibid*, was filed on 4.1.2018. It is an attempt to harass and humiliate the petitioner and therefore, transfer of the petition has been sought.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-husband submitted that the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C was filed post receipt of summons in the divorce petition, therefore cannot be a ground for

transfer and urges this Court for dismissal of the transfer application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and appraised the paper book and of the view that there is no force and merit in the petition as the distance between Jalandhar and Amritsar is hardly 80 K.Ms and the other two petitions have been filed after receipt of the summons in the divorce petition on 4.1.2018.

I do not find it a fit case for transfer of the divorce petition. The transfer application is dismissed.
