Main Case

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition titled as “***Renu vs J.P. Chaudhary***”, under the Guardianship & Wards Act, 1890, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mohindergarh, to a competent Court at Rewari.

Short reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed.

It comes out that the petition under the Guardianship & Wards Act, 1890 was filed by the petitioner herself in the year 2015 at Civil Courts, Mohindergarh. The case is pending for evidence for the last two years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on the last date of hearing, the evidence of the petitioner was concluded and now the case is fixed for tomorrow i.e. 17.02.2018 for recording the evidence of the respondent. It goes to show that the case is almost mature. Therefore, there is no ground to transfer the same at this stage.
