It comes out that earlier on the petition of present petitioner, vide order dated 13.11.2017, passed by a coordinate bench of this Court in TA No. 390-2017, titled as *Manu Priya Versus Devinder Singh*, divorce petition was transferred from Bathinda Courts to Tarn Taran Courts. Now, with new facts, instant petition has come up, stating that earlier counsel did not mention some facts. Therefore, petitioner seeks transfer of case from Tarn Taran Courts to Amritsar Courts.

I am of view that it was on the request of petitioner that the case was transferred from Bathinda Courts to Tarn Taran Courts. There is not much distance between Tarn Taran Courts and Amritsar Courts. No ground to transfer the case again from Tarn Taran Courts to Amritsar Courts is made out. Consequently, instant petition is dismissed.
