Respondent has been served through counsel before the trial Court but no representation has been made on his behalf. Hence, proceeded against ex-parte.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as **“Lokesh versus Smt. Monika”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is unable to go from Hisar to Gurgaon Courts to pursue her case.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and the fact that none has appeared to oppose the petition, the petition titled as **“Lokesh versus Smt. Monika”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Hisar, who may retain the
