Respondent is reported to be served through mother but no representation has been made on his behalf. Hence, proceeded against ex-parte.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/148/2017 titled as **“Kalyan versus Sudesh Rani”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Karnal to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that two other cases between the parties are already pending at Kaithal Courts and it is difficult for her to travel from Kaithal to pursue her case at Karnal Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by the petitioner; the fact that none has appeared to oppose the petition and in order to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties should be tried at one place, petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in case No. HMA/148/2017 titled as **“Kalyan versus Sudesh Rani”** pending in the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Karnal is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Kaithal, who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
