Petitioner seeks transfer of the case bearing No.HMA/23, dated 06.05.2016, titled as "*Tejbir vs Manju*", filed under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Hisar, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jind.

Heard.

It is stated that the minor child is living with his mother at Jind. Therefore, the jurisdiction to try the case under the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, is at Jind Courts. As such, the case bearing No.HMA/23, dated 06.05.2016, titled as "*Tejbir vs Manju*", filed under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Hisar, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Jind, who may try the case himself or entrust it to a Court of competent jurisdiction.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
